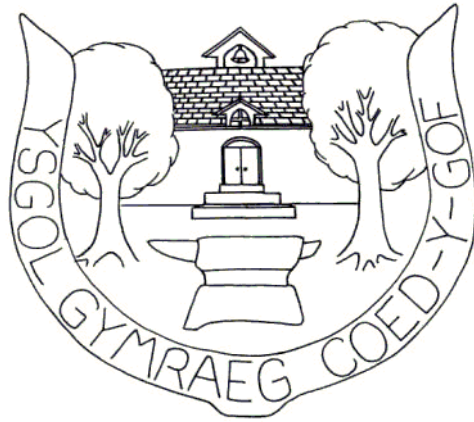

# Annual Report of the Governing Body to Parents 2020 – 21



## GOVERNORS' ANNUAL REPORT TO PARENTS 2020 – 2021

Dear Parent / Guardian,

As Chair of the Governing Body, I am proud to present the annual report for Ysgol Gymraeg Coed-y-Gof.

It would of course be impossible to present this report without recognising the exceptional situation that the school, like all others, faced this year. When we set out our priorities for 2020/21 last August we were hopeful for a year uninterrupted by the constraints of a further pandemic – how optimistic we were! As Governors, we have been bowled over by the School's response to the effects of Covid. Such care has gone into planning at every stage – whether the School was only open to vulnerable pupils and the children of key workers, or since March when we operated with class bubbles in place. This would not have been possible without the dedication of the team of staff, who have continued to work through huge challenges for the benefit of our pupils. I would also like to express how proud I am of how the school coped with this unusual situation and overcame the challenges in a professional and effective manner. We are extremely grateful to everyone, as I am sure you are. We are also grateful to you, our families, for your support and understanding during these difficult times.

Although the pandemic has affected the year, we have managed to accomplish some of the things we set out to do. I hope that this report will be a useful summary of the year.

As a Governing body we have a strategic role in shaping the school's aims and policies, and work with the headteacher and staff to deliver them. We act as a critical friend who asks challenging questions, but also provides the support and means to achieve any of the objectives. The last two years have sent us in a very different direction to normal, with a greater emphasis on health and safety than ever before, in an effort to ensure that our staff and pupils attend school as safely as possible.

The pandemic has presented many challenges for all of us, alongside the usual standards, school funding and maintenance, and a new curriculum. We will continue to work hard to ensure that the school is a happy, caring environment that nurtures our pupils, and prepares them for the next stage in their education.

On behalf of the whole governing body I would like to take this opportunity to thank Mrs Prytherch, the school's Leadership Team and all the teaching and ancillary staff, for the incredible work that has taken place over the past year.

## CURRICULUM

Work is carefully planned to ensure that all pupils are appropriately supported and challenged to enable them to reach their full potential. ## ADDITIONAL LEARNING NEEDS

The Additional Learning Needs Co-ordinator (ALNCo), Mrs Casey, ensures that the specific requirements of each child are met. Learning Support Assistants also work with children of all abilities under the guidance of the class teacher and ALNCo. Elin Stock is the governor with responsibility for the field and in normal circumstances, she would visit the school to discuss the progress of pupils and ensure that standards were maintained. ## **SCHOOL COUNCIL AND DRAGONS**

Coed-y-Gof School Council is a community of children elected by their peers at the beginning of each year. The council's main aim is to come together to offer a voice to all children in the school. Each class from Year 1 to Year 6 will elect one member, with Year 6 members taking responsibility for chairing. At the beginning of the year, council members will decide on open-ended targets and through discussions between council members and their classes, steps will be taken to achieve targets that are sure to improve the school life of our pupils. The Council was co-ordinated by Mrs Aimee Meyer.

## **LEARNER VOICE**

In addition to the forum through its class representative, learners influence curriculum content by participating fully in the thematic planning at the beginning of each Term. This gives pupils a sense of respect and ownership as they pursue a learning path designed by themselves.

## **HEALTH AND SAFETY**

The safety and wellbeing of our pupils is more important than any other consideration. The Headteacher or a member of the Leadership Team will be on duty every morning and afternoon to ensure the safety of the pupils.

Staff are on duty at 8:40am and the external doors and gates close at 8:55am. Anyone arriving at the school after this time must go to reception to register. Staff duty periods follow a similar pattern during the day when supervising the hall and yard during break times. A designated member of staff with a First Aid qualification will be available for each break time.

## **RESPONSE TO COVID-19**

The school had robust risk assessments in place to ensure it continued to operate safely under Covid regulations. The school had to close to pupils for a period from December 15th to February 23rd 2021 due to the Covid-19 pandemic. During this period, blended learning provision was available for pupils learning from home. A childcare Hub was held during this lockdown for vulnerable pupils and children of key workers, on the school site.
