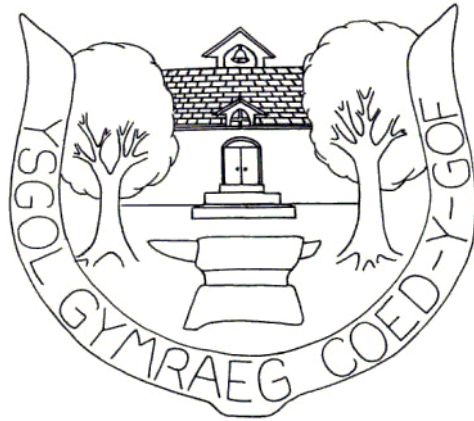

Annual Report of the Governing Body to Parents 2019–20



THE GOVERNORS ANNUAL REPORT TO PARENTS 2019 – 2020

In normal circumstances, I would be pleased to share this report with you on behalf of the Governing Body of Ysgol Gymraeg Coed-y-Gof, giving you details of the academic year 2019 – 2020. The report would look at the school's successes during the period, those that we have said goodbye to and those that we have welcomed, as well as future targets and the school's forward planning.

However, this year has been anything but normal for all of us. The advent of COVID-19 in March led to a very different school year, with the school closed to pupils for a period. As such, not all aspects of this report are available, such as the usual data, attendance figures etc.

As a Governing body we have a strategic role in shaping the school's aims and policies, and then working with the headteacher and staff to deliver them. We act as a critical friend who asks challenging questions, but also provides the support and means to achieve any objectives. This year has sent us in a very different direction to normal, with a greater emphasis on health and safety than ever before, in an effort to prepare the school, staff and our children for at least a different start to the year.

Normal school improvement planning was generally delayed with an end to statutory education.

The pandemic presents many challenges for all of us, alongside the usual standards, school funding and maintenance, and a new curriculum. We will continue to work hard to ensure that the school is a happy, caring environment that nurtures their pupils, and prepares them for the next stage in their education.

SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

All statutory requirements for school improvement planning were deferred following the closure in March. However, Mrs Prytherch and staff continued to plan for the introduction of the new curriculum in Wales and the ALN law, as well as preparing the re-opening of the school in Covid-safe in June and then September.

CURRICULUM

Ysgol Gymraeg Coed-y-Gof is clear on our aspirations for the school curriculum. Our aim is to offer an exciting curriculum that inspires all our children and staff. All work is carefully planned to ensure that all pupils are appropriately supported and challenged to enable them to reach their full potential. As a school we have been preparing for the introduction of the new curriculum based on the Four Purposes.

ADDITIONAL LEARNING NEEDS

The Additional Learning Needs Co-ordinator (ALNCo), Mrs Casey, ensures that the specific requirements of each child are met. Learning Support Assistants also work with children of all abilities under the guidance of the class teacher and ALNCo. Elin Cousins is the governor with responsibility for the field and in normal circumstances, she would visit the school to discuss the progress of pupils and ensure that standards were maintained. SCHOOL COUNCIL AND DRAGONS

Coed-y-Gof School Council is a community of children elected by their peers at the beginning of each year. The council's main aim is to come together to offer a voice to all children in the school. Each class from Year 1 to Year 6 will elect one member, with Year 6 members taking responsibility for chairing. At the beginning of the year, council members will decide on open-ended targets and through discussions between council members and their classes, steps will be taken to achieve targets that are sure to improve the school life of our pupils. The Council was co-ordinated by Mrs Aimee Meyer.

LEARNER VOICE

In addition to the forum through its class representative, learners influence curriculum content when participating fully in the thematic planning at the beginning of each Term. This gives pupils a sense of respect and ownership as they pursue a learning path designed by themselves.

HEALTH AND SAFETY

The safety and wellbeing of our pupils is more important than any other consideration. The Headteacher or a member of the senior management team will be on duty every morning and afternoon to ensure pupil safety.

During the year a new system was introduced to register visitors to the school, which takes a picture and records it electronically.

We reviewed our supervision at break times and have increased the number of staff on yard break duty. Three areas of the school are designated as duty areas and staff supervise these on a daily basis. Staff yard duty starts at 8:40am with the external doors and gates closing at 8:55 am. Anyone arriving at the school after this time must go to reception to register. Staff duty periods follow a similar pattern during the day when supervising the hall and yard during break times. A designated member of staff with a First Aid qualification will be available for each break time.

RESPONSE TO COVID-19

The school had to close to pupils for a period of March 23rd following National Legislation in the wake of the Covid-19 pandemic. During this period, safeguarding measures were introduced following advice from Local Authority officers.

The school re-opened to groups of 8 children in each class from 29th June 2021, following strict health and safety regulations.
