Annwyl Rieni a Gofalwyr,

Fel y byddwch yn ymwybodol, bydd Coed-y-Gof yn agor dau ddosbarth SRB newydd i gefnogi plant ag anghenion iechyd emosiynol a llesiant. Bydd y dosbarth cyntaf, ar gyfer disgyblion 7–11 oed, yn agor ym mis Medi 2026, a bydd yr ail ddosbarth ar gyfer disgyblion 4–7 oed yn agor ym mis Ionawr 2027.

Er mwyn paratoi ar gyfer y dosbarthiadau newydd hyn, mae angen gwneud rhywfaint o waith adeiladu a newidiadau i drefniant y ysgol. Er y bydd y rhan fwyaf o'r gwaith yn cael ei wneud dros wyliau'r haf, mae angen dechrau rhywfaint o waith paratoadol yn gynharach, a bydd hyn yn arwain at ambell newid dros dro o fewn y ysgol.

Ar ddiwedd yr wythnos hon, bydd dosbarth Gwernen yn symud i'r hyn sydd ar hyn o bryd yn y llyfrgell. Gallwn eich sicrhau y bydd y cyfleusterau yn yr ystafell hon yr un mor addas â'u hystafell arferol. Disgwylir i'r trefniant hwn bara am tua chwe wythnos. Wedi hynny, bydd dosbarth Gwernen yn symud i'w hystafell ddosbarth barhaol, sydd yn union gyferbyn â'u hystafell bresennol.

Yn ystod y gwaith adeiladu, bydd rhai rhannau o'r ysgol allan o ffiniau i ddisgyblion er mwyn sicrhau eu diogelwch. Bydd disgyblion y Cyfnod Sylfaen yn mynd i mewn ac allan o'r adeilad drwy'r iard, a byddant yn defnyddio'r toiledau yn nosbarth Meithrin, sydd gyferbyn â'u hystafell. Bydd hyn yn caniatáu i'r toiledau Cyfnod Sylfaen presennol gael eu hadnewyddu — gwelliant sydd wedi bod yn hir ddisgwylidig. Fodd bynnag, golyga hyn y bydd angen i ddisgyblion y Cyfnod Sylfaen fynd allan i gyrraedd y toiledau a'r neuadd. Gobeithiwn am dywydd braf, ond gofynnwn i chi gadw hyn mewn cof wrth anfon eich plant i'r ysgol, gan y gallai fod angen cot law arnynt.

Bydd adeiladwyr ar y safle am tua phedwar mis. Bydd eu cyfleusterau eu hunain, gan gynnwys toiledau, wedi'u lleoli yng nghefn yr ysgol. Bydd pob contractwr ar y safle wedi cael gwiriad DBS.

Rydym yn gwerthfawrogi y gall y newidiadau dros dro hyn effeithio ar drefn ddyddiol arferol y ysgol. Fodd bynnag, rydym yn hyderus y bydd manteision hirdymor y gwelliannau hyn o fudd i bob disgybl, nawr ac yn y dyfodol.

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, Coed-y-Gof will be opening two new SRB classes to support children with emotional health and well-being needs. The first class, for pupils aged 7–11, will open in September 2026, followed by a second class for pupils aged 4–7 in January 2027.

To prepare for these new classes, some building work and changes to the school layout are required. While most of the work will take place during the summer holidays, some preparatory work needs to begin sooner, which will result in a few temporary changes within the school.

At the end of this week, Gwernen class will move into the current library space. Please be assured that the facilities in this room will be equivalent to those in their usual classroom. This arrangement will last for approximately six weeks. After this, Gwernen class will move into their long-term classroom, located directly opposite their current room.

During the building work, some areas of the school will be out of bounds to pupils to ensure everyone's safety. Foundation phase pupils will enter and leave the building via the yard and will use the toilets in the Meithrin class, opposite their classroom. This will allow the current foundation toilets to undergo a long-awaited refurbishment. However, this means that access to the toilets and the main hall for Foundation Phase pupils will require going outside. While we are hopeful for plenty of fine weather, please bear this in mind when sending your children to school, as they may need a coat.

Builders will be on site for approximately four months. They will be based at the rear of the school and will have their own facilities, including restrooms. All contractors working on site will be DBS checked.

We appreciate that these temporary changes may cause some disruption to the usual day-to-day running of the school. However, we are confident that the improvements will bring long-term benefits for all our pupils, both now and in the future.
